The day is organised by Mission Agencies Partnership (MAP) at **Belfast Bible College** on **Saturday 27th February 2010 from 10am - 4pm**. Our main speaker is **Peter Teagle**, who works for Friends International, envisioning and enabling churches in Oxford to reach and disciple international students. Locally

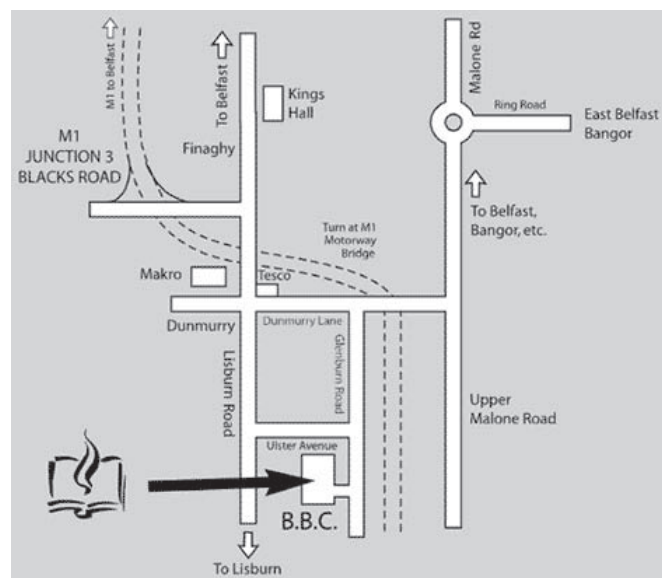

Coming from Belfast on the M1

Leave at the Blacks Road Junction (3) and follow the signs for Dunmurry, turning left on to Dunmurry Lane at Tesco and the traffic lights at Dunmurry Crossroads.

Coming from the South on the M1.

Leave at the Kings Hall Junction (2), go around the roundabout and re-enter the M1 going west. Follow instructions as from Belfast (above).
